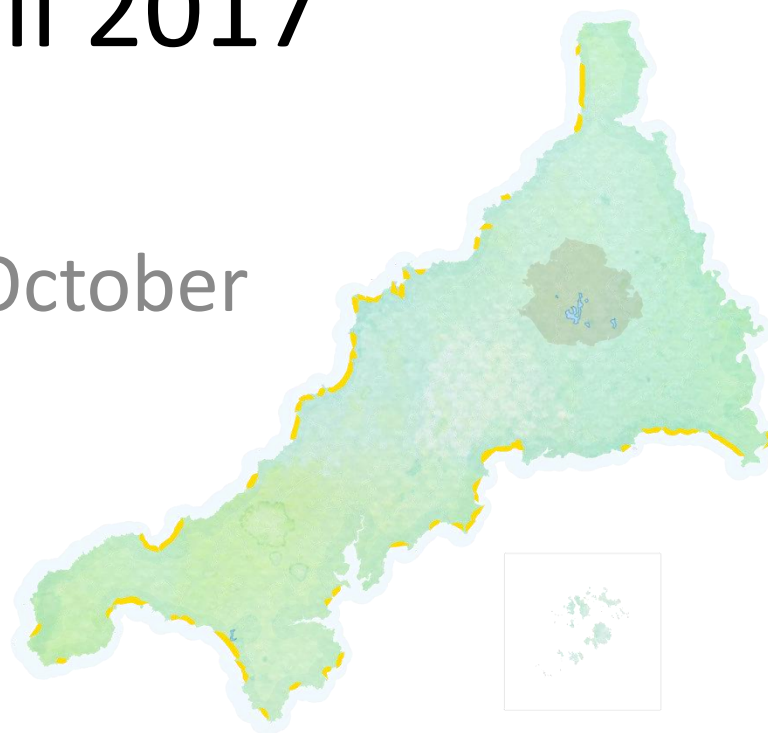

- There is also a buffet at dinner time which serves breads, hams, cheeses, jacket potatoes, wedges, soups and salads.
- Dessert range from a variety of mousses to chocolate brownies, sticky toffee pudding and apple crumble.
- The cooked breakfast is a range of baps, bacon, sausage, egg and mushroom as well as a continental selection of pastries, pain au chocolate, croissants and cinnamon swirls. There is also a selection of toasts and cereals.
- The bagged breakfast will contain two pastries usually pain au chocolate or croissant, water and a fruit selection. The packed lunches will contain either ham, cheese or tuna sandwiches a cookie or a fruit bar a packet of crisps, piece of fruit and a bottle of water. Any dietary requirements will be specifically catered for.

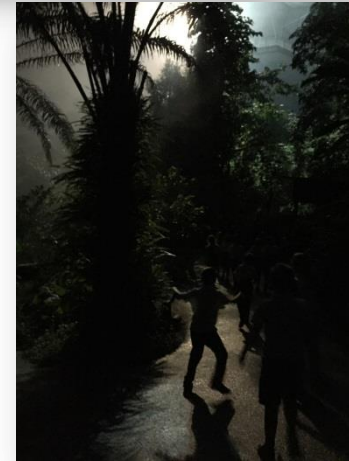
- Flambards! Not just the rides. There's a fantastic Victorian Village too and a WW2 experience.

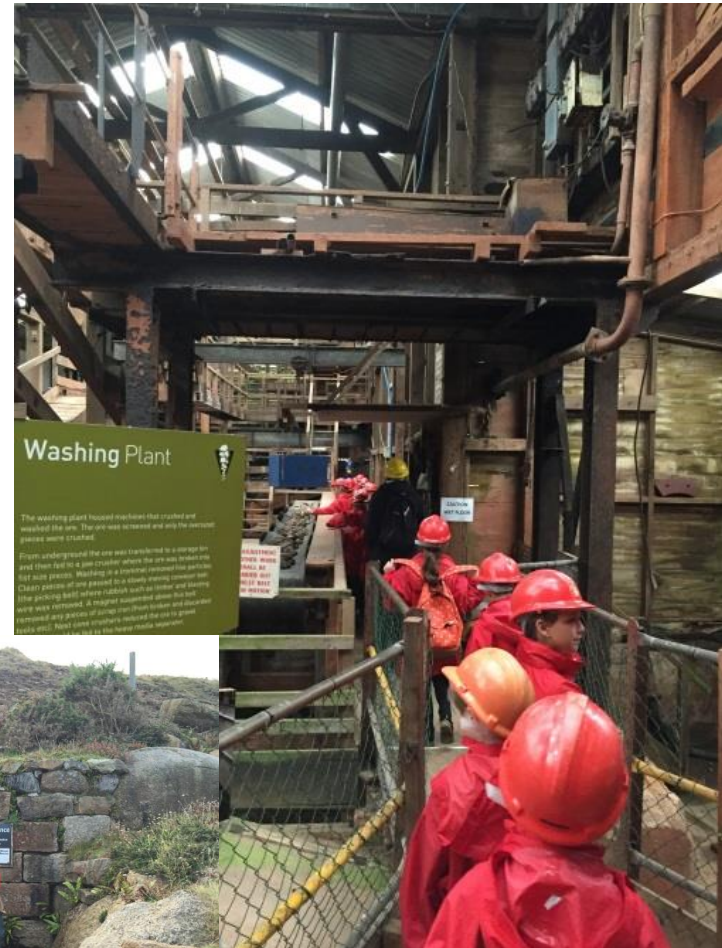
# St Michael's Mount
