

Dear Parents and Carers,

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I have the pleasure of informing you of our exciting new staffing structure for the 2021-2022 academic year. The new structure is based on teaching teams within the three phases of our school – Reception and KS1, lower KS2 and Upper KS2. Each phase will function as a 'mini school'. Every class will have its own teacher with each of the 'mini schools' being led by a designated School Improvement Leader.

The School Improvement Leads, or SILs, will continue to teach across the classes within their mini schools, as well as driving forward our Curriculum 360.

This is an exciting change to our structure, which will increase the number of qualified teachers and provide greater distributed leadership across the school. Having more teachers than classes within the mini school will allow for a more flexible approach to teaching, ensuring that we meet the needs of all the children.

Miss Rebekah Hester will be on a sabbatical for a year, returning next September after her travels around the world!

The children will be meeting their new teachers on a transition day on Monday  $19^{\text{th}}$  July.

We strongly believe that this new staffing structure, supported by Character Education and our Enrichment Programme, will enable us to focus on every child as an individual. We are ambitious that every child should take ownership of their own learning, character and wellbeing and be at the front and centre of our decisionmaking in school.
