## Childhood

## Literacy

### Key Texts:

Our texts are focussed around Family for the first few weeks.

Using our phonics to help us spell words and putting them into sentences. Firstly concentrating on Oracy to build sentences that make sense and then writing them.

We look at different sentence types and through wonderful texts, we explore the grammar and punctuation of different sentences.

### Religious Education

We look at answering the question...Who made the world? Discussing and valuing different thoughts and beliefs.

### Art

We are lucky to have the expertise of our Art specialist to support in Year 1. The children will develop skills in using a range of media from chalk to oil pastels, paints and ink.

### Design and Technology

Linking to our childhood topic and looking back at toys of the past, we focus on Textiles in DT. Designing a toy for a specific audience with a particular purpose.
