Numeracy

We continue daily fluency of maths facts including number bonds to 10 and 20, counting in 2s 5s and 10s, counting on from any given number up and back to 100.

Addition and subtraction this term consolidates their learning but builds confidence in using larger numbers. We also look at Weight and Volume, Length and Height.

<u>P.E.</u>

The Spring term covers multi skills. Gymnastics and Dance. Exciting news for this term....we have a professional coach on a Monday for PE which will develop our core skills.

Computing

We look at the differences when using skills with and without technology – drawing, writing, researching. During the second half term, the children will learn some simple programming.

Music

With the benefit of our specialist Music teacher the class will be developing skills in performing, listening and composing music of different genres.
