## <u>Numeracy</u>

We begin to develop our understanding of place value this term. Daily fluency will build skills in counting and number bonds to 10. We then move to counting in 2s and 10s.

We will be able to sort items by different categories and we start to understand addition and subtraction. The maths lessons and mostly practical using resources to support learning and mastering these basic skills which form the foundation of their maths knowledge.

# <u>P.E.</u>

We are excited to have Tom Poole to support us for PE this term. He will take the PE session on Thursday starting with multi skills where they will develop catching, throwing, jumping and running skills. On Friday afternoons, the children will have another PE session which will begin with Dance.

## <u>Computing</u>

We look at early programming skills using Beebots. The children will learn to make commands and will become a human Beebot with their friends programming them to move around the class.

## <u>Music</u>

With the benefit of our specialist Music teacher the class will be developing skills in performing, listening and composing music of different genres.

# Character Education & PSED

We begin looking at the Character Virtues – starting with motivation. The children will have the opportunity to be inspiring leaders by taking responsibility in the classroom and later in the term being Inspiring Learners when they will learn a new skill. This work will count towards their final Inspiring Changemaker Awards at the end of the year.

### <u>Humanities</u>

History

Movers & Shakers. We study significant people from the past and today. We learn about monuments and what makes someone significant.

#### <u>Science</u>

We focus on Animals this term, but also spend some time understanding the change in seasons and the weather. We take time in the forest area and enjoy our outside environment.

# <u>Literacy</u> <u>Key Texts:</u>

#### Hairy Maclairy

Looking at rhyming. This links with our animals topic in Science.

Traditional Fairy Tales – tell stories to each other and then learning a short text which we can adapt using our own ideas.

We will begin our writing during our phonics sessions and then using our phonics to help us spell words and putting them into sentences. Oracy continues to play an important part of the learning. Practicing saying sentences out loud and experimenting with vocabulary before putting pencil to paper.

# Religious Education

We look at the celebrating difference and the Christian religion this term and compare it to other beliefs.

# <u>Art</u>

We are lucky to have the expertise of our Art specialist to support in Year 1. The children will develop skills in using a range of media from chalk to oil pastels, paints and ink.

## Design and Technology

After half term we will begin our D&T module. This will enable us to learn new skills and work towards our inspiring learner award.
