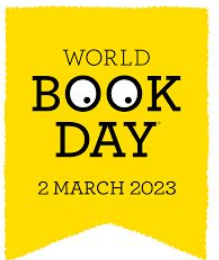
How are the frozen kingdoms important to humans and wildlife? If Antarctica was a piece of music it would be Beethoven. Agree or disagree?

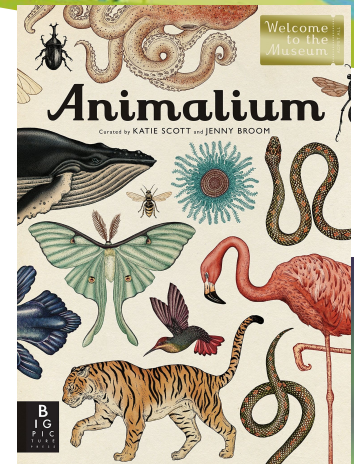

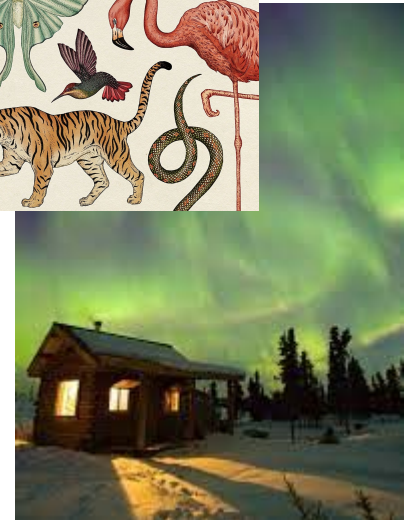
